Because it connects with another world, prayer comes to have a particular freedom of form. In rituals, conversely, it is highly structured and adheres to conventions such as the *amen*, with which almost every Christian prayer closes.

The Annual Exhibition of the Abbey Library illustrates the development of Christian prayer in its many different forms. It is complemented by Katharina Heigl's photographic exhibition entitled *Faces in Prayer*, which presents people of different religions praying.
