



House rules

We warmly welcome you to our museum and wish you a pleasant stay.

The house rules serve to make your visit to our museum as pleasant as possible. They are obligatory for all guests. By entering the museum building, you accept our regulations as well as any other rules made to ensure operational safety. The protection of persons and cultural assets in the building is of paramount importance to us.

- Your stay in our premises entails an obligation to comply with the house rules.
- For security reasons, the exhibition areas are under video surveillance.
- The objects on display may not be touched, harmed or interfered with in any way. Visitors are liable for any damage they may cause.
- Prams are not allowed in the exhibition areas. They may be left at the entrance on the ground floor.
- Unless otherwise indicated, photography for purely personal use is permitted without the use of flash, tripod or selfie stick. Professional photography and filming require permission.
- Smoking is prohibited throughout the buildings. Food and drink are not permitted in the exhibition areas.
- Animals likewise are not permitted in the exhibition areas. The only exceptions are assistance dogs.
- Bags, suitcases, backpacks, musical instruments, umbrellas must be left in the cloakroom or lockers. Large lockable wheeled baskets are available for school classes and groups. We accept no liability for the cloakroom or lockers.
- Items deposited in the lockers must be removed before leaving the building. For security reasons, the lockers are opened and emptied every evening by museum staff.
- Teachers, group leaders and guardians are responsible for the appropriate behaviour of children and young people in their charge. Shouting and running are forbidden in the exhibition areas.
- Improper behaviour such as disruptive conduct, in particular towards other visitors and museum staff, is prohibited.
- Out of consideration for other visitors, please refrain from using your mobile phone.

The instructions of the museum staff must be followed at all times. Violations of the house rules may lead to expulsion, criminal prosecution and claims for damages. In the event of an expulsion, the admission fee will not be refunded. We thank you for your understanding and wish you a pleasant stay.
